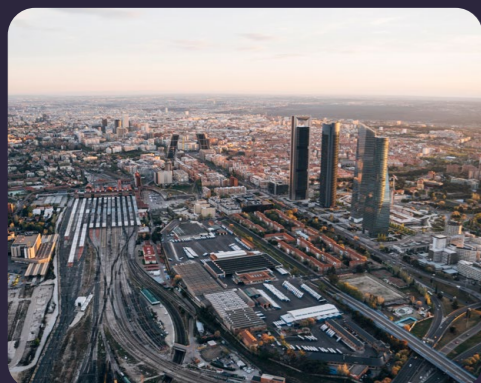
Charting Paths of Hope

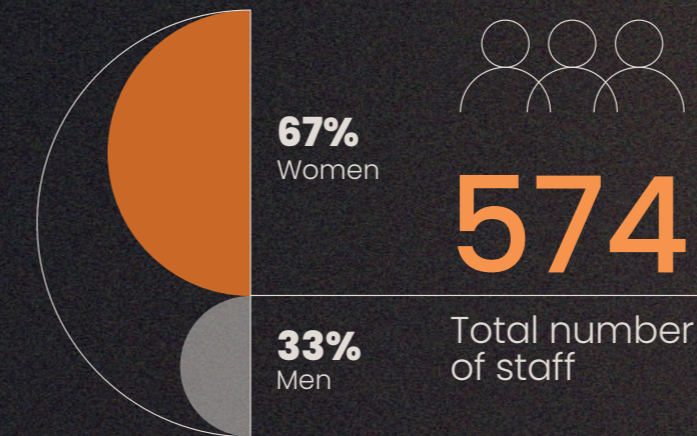
